There was likely little thought of the Indigenous folks who once called this home.

Nearly 100 years ago, this church united with other denominations to form The United Church of Canada, with little regard for the role of Indigenous folks.

Indian residential schools opened and closed with support from our church, which stood by as Indigenous children were taken and given to non-Indigenous families.

In 1986, The United Church apologized for its role in disenfranchising Indigenous people.

In 1998, it apologized for its role with the residential schools.

We recognize the Esquimalt and Songhees, parts of the $l = k^w = \eta = 1$ whose care of this land predates contact with Europeans and others.

As the journey of reconciling continues, we trust God will lead us all to right relationship, however long and arduous the journey.


